Average temperatures in Stockholm in December: -3°C to 1°C | 27°F to 34°F



Daily sunshine hours in December: 2 hours

Please ensure to carry the necessary documents PRINTED and with you (not in your checked-in luggage).

Arrivals - Currency

The monetary unit in Sweden is the krona SEK (plural “kronor”).

Please note that Sweden has yet to ratify the Euro treaty, which means that you cannot pay using Euros (€) – or other currencies than SEK – in cash.

Please note that Sweden is a mostly cashless society. Most of the country’s bank branches have stopped handling cash; many shops, museums and restaurants now only accept plastic or mobile payments. Major credit cards are widely accepted throughout Sweden at banks, hotels, stores, restaurants, or taxis.

Before travelling, please check with your bank to reduce charges.

Arrivals - Airport Transfers

From Stockholm Arlanda

By train: the Arlanda Express will take you to Stockholm Central Station every 10-15 minutes throughout the day. The travel time is 18 minutes. It costs extra to purchase a ticket onboard the train, so it is recommended to buy tickets online, at the airport information desks or from a ticket machine. First train from Arlanda to Stockholm Central is at 04h50 and the last is at 01:05.

By taxi: it takes 40-45 minutes to reach the hotel depending on traffic.

From Stockholm Bromma

By bus: Flygbussarna Airport Coaches operate from Bromma Stockholm Airport once or twice every hour on weekdays. Travel time is 20 minutes. Ticket can be bought online or on the bus.

By taxi: it takes approximately 20 minutes to reach the hotel depending on traffic.

From Stockholm Skavsta

By bus: Flygbussarna Airport Coaches depart from Stockholm Skavsta Airport to Stockholm multiple times a day. The trip last 80 minutes.


By taxi: it takes approximately one hour to reach the hotel depending on traffic.

From Västerås Airport

By bus: Flygbussarna Airport Coaches operate between Stockholm Västerås Airport and Stockholm C on some days. Travel time is 80 minutes.

By taxi: it takes approximately one hour to reach the hotel depending on traffic.

Arrivals - Conference Venue




The meeting will take place at the [Scandic Continental Hotel](#), located at Vasagatan 22, 111 20 Stockholm, Sweden.

Hotel - Conference Room


The main Conference Room is located rooms n°17&18, on floor 3.

Hot drinks and snacks are available at anytime in the breakout area on floor 3.


Hotel - Lunch

The Social Dinner will take place on Wednesday, November 30 at 19h00.




Social Events - Reception
