

- Surveillance: Use information to anticipate, prepare and effectively respond to challenges
- Policy making: Use of surveillance data for evidence-based decision making
- Evaluation: Regular monitoring and analysis of the system for continuous improvement

Observation: 1467 cumulative deaths reported with case fatality rate: 1.1%, No death reported within 55 days




eIDSR used for routine collection of data from mainly health-based sources: Indicator based surveillance ANPHI






